The University of Tennessee, Nashville (UTN) was one of five primary campuses in the University of Tennessee System, which still includes the University of Tennessee, Knoxville (UT); University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC); University of Tennessee at Martin (UTM); and the University of Tennessee Health Science Center (UTHSC). UTN began operations in 1947 and was accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACS COC) in the same year to award Master's degrees. UTN continued in accreditation until 1979 when it merged into Tennessee State University (see attached letter from SACS COC).

The University of Tennessee, Knoxville is the custodial institution for UTN academic records. Former UTN students needing access to UTN transcripts should contact
