My dear Mr. Smith:

I have your letter of the 7th which was written in explanation of the telegram you sent me to which I replied as follows:

"Dr. Sprowls not dismissed. He was informed that he would not be recommended for reappointment next year. The usual method has been followed. We give early notification in such cases to enable persons concerned to make readjustments for following year. The University expects similar early notification from persons who intend to withdraw."

I am sure that you will feel from my telegram that the press statement does not in any way represent the facts and that my telegram to you has made clear that the University is pursuing the same policy as heretofore.
