SACSCOC requested additional information via email on October 4, 2024. The institution's response on October 14, 2024, was added to the record and is reflected in the narrative below.

At the time the decision to close was made, no students were enrolled in the Graduate Certificate in Urbanism. The decision to close the current program was made in February 20, 2020.

No students required options to complete the program.

The institutional community was informed of the closure. The Graduate Certificate in Urbanism was never advertised or used for recruitment; therefore, prospective students will not need to be informed. The institution continues to offer the program as a concentration in the Master of Architecture. Should any prospective student express an interest in the program, they will be directed to the Master of Architecture. Faculty and staff were informed by participation in the decision to close the method of delivery.

No students will incur additional costs.

No faculty or staff will be impacted by this closure.

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the late closure of the Graduate Certificate in Urbanism.
