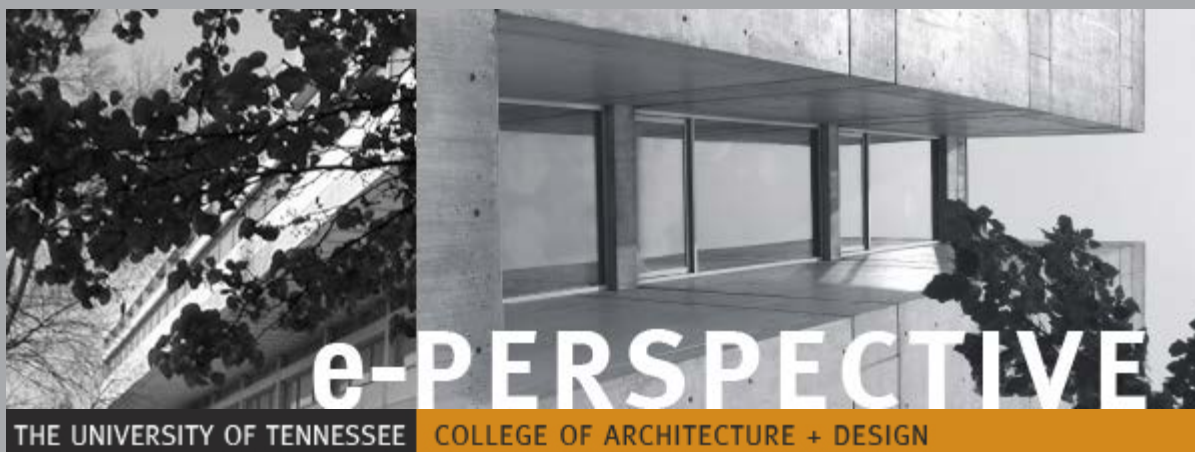




#### **FORMER INTERIOR DESIGN PROGRAM COORDINATOR JOSETTE RABUN RETIRES**
