



Existing lot for parking

Street traffic is abated and pedestrian activity is encouraged with a sidewalk arcade inhabiting the first bay of Knox Heritage

The formal office space for Knox Heritage is given a private mezzanine level which inhabits the clerestory zone above the various other functions of the organization, such as architectural salvage, archive, gallery, museum, and event space

A conference room in the office mezzanine overlooks the event space below

A large event space for the hosting events is flanked by new interior partitions with salvaged windows

A second stairway and floor cutaway further mediates the levels and various programs and encourages movement into the interior of the site, further aided by a platform which extend into the alley behind

NORTH BROADWAY

KNOX HERITAGE

A flexible outdoor room is created to facilitate many uses. It acts as equal parts sculpture park, secret picnic location, and alternative event venue

RUIN GARDEN

Greenhouse roof and raised beds for cultivation. The existing industrial glazing aids the greenhouse effect.

GREENHOUSE NURSERY AND FLOWER SHOP

The flower shop accompanies the greenhouse, opening up to a view of the cemetery

TYSON STREET NW

Another quiet street on the southwest edge of the site, together with the wall, serves as a threshold to Old Gray
