Dear Dr. Albrecht:

Thank you for your letter of April 28, 2015, notifying SACSCOC of your intention to implement a dual degree agreement between the UT College of Engineering and Maryville College, effective March 20, 2015.

Under the terms of the agreement, a student will spend three or four years at Maryville College, then complete the requirements for an engineering degree at the UT College of Engineering. Upon completion of degree requirements, the student will receive a baccalaureate degree from Maryville College and a B.S. in Engineering degree from the University of Tennessee.
