SUBJECT: Statistics on Applications for Admissions

DATE: August 11, 1972

Attached is a revision of the July 1st Comparison between applications for admissions for 1971 and 1972. This revision is necessitated because I inadvertently omitted some data which had been submitted and because of a misunderstanding as to the types of applications to be included in the survey. Please use this new table in any analyses you make.

Also, you might want to note three statistics which do not appear on the table. If we consider all undergraduate applications, ie, freshman plus undergraduate transfer applications, we see that applications at the senior institutions are down by 2.02%, applications at the community colleges are up by 26.46%, and applications at all institutions are up by .05%.

We will make one last survey this year, as of September 1st. (Detailed instructions will be sent to the appropriate persons.) I anticipate that similar surveys will be conducted in future years and I would appreciate your communicating to me any suggestions, questions, or comments you may have concerning the design or use of the survey. Thank you.
