CHANGING ENROLLMENT OF BLACKS AT UTK

The Fall 1976 black student enrollment at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville increased by 121 over the Fall 1975 enrollment, reaching a total of 1,373. This represents 9.7 percent increase in black enrollment, compared with an increase of 8 percent in all state public colleges and universities as reported by THEC. This increase was anticipated inspite of the lower number of new applicants for Fall 1976. A greater percentage of enrollment of the new students was expected as applicants in general appear to be more serious in applying for admission to the institution at which they seriously plan to attend. This is influenced by the application fee and the nonrefundable housing deposit now required.

The University of Tennessee, Knoxville is continuing to examine the total black recruiting program. Use is being made of the ACT Educational Opportunity Services Program to identify black high school graduates who will possibly be interested in the programs at this campus. Use of the National Achievement Scholarship Program for Outstanding Negroes in Tennessee list is being continued. It is evident that the University of Tennessee, Knoxville is progressing rapidly toward its goal of 1,625 black students by 1980.
