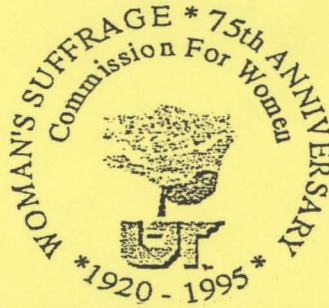

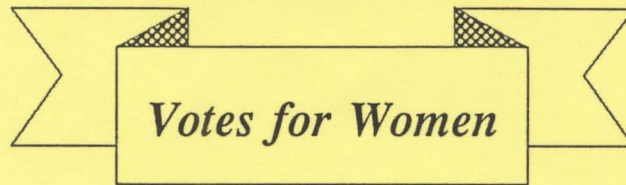

Tickets are \$5.00, and the proceeds will go to the East Tennessee Foundation's 75th Suffrage Anniversary Coalition Statue Project.
