RE: Meeting with President Edward Boling

President Edward Boling has agreed to meet with the Commission For Blacks at 3:30, on Wednesday, November 17 in the Chancellor's Conference Room, Fifth Floor, Andy Holt Tower.

As you may recall one of the principal reasons for meeting with President Boling is to elicit his views with respect to attracting qualified Blacks to professional schools such as Law, Medicine and Dentistry. Further, since we rarely have an opportunity to meet with the President there may be other pertinent concerns which you may wish to discuss. If so, will you please forward agenda items to me.
