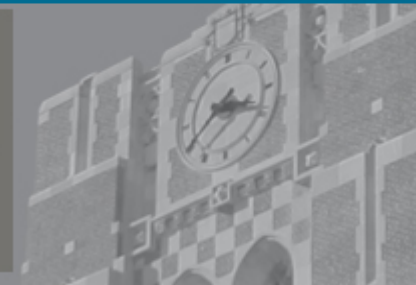

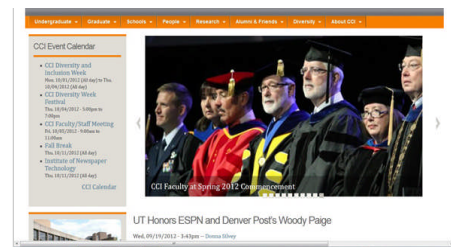




UT Hosts Diversity and Inclusion Week
