I would call your attention to the statement of the following accounts.

Furniture and Equipment has overdrawn	18.03
Expense .. ..	16.05

The following have a balance which will likely be overdrawn by the bills of the month; Repair 28.73, Chem. 7.83.

Library 28.31, Grounds 145.57. not including a balance of 86.00 on cidenalk.

An appropriation ought to be made to pay salary of E. M. Davis an instructor 6 mos. at 15 = \$90, also 45 for library to pay her salary for 3 mos. at 15. per month.

The bal. on Grounds account will not be sufficient for May and June. as the month of April cost over \$150.

Bot. and Stat. has a balance of 31.42, which will hardly be sufficient.

Orders have been sent in for cuts, seals and photographs for which there is no appropriation.

There is a large balance to the credit of Adm. + Printing amounting to 564.00. and 555.90 to the credit of Instr. Expenses. Will these amounts be used by future bills?

The amt paid out on Fuel & C&D since Jan, 1<sup>st</sup> is 235.29. but as I have collected 230.14 since then, there is not use for the 200 approp. unless to pay back bills of Fuel. before Jan, 1<sup>st</sup>. As far as I can judge the other appropriations are sufficient and need no statement.
