During a six-month stay in Uganda, she met victims of horrific violence. When she returned, her primary goal was to teach the children there about peace and reconciliation.

That theme of peace and justice without bitterness are also central to her Baker Scholars project. She serves as president of UT's chapter of Amnesty International is involved in the UT Jazz for Justice. She was nominated for her compassion, her respect, and her depth of human understanding, which is described as remarkable and simply breathtaking.
