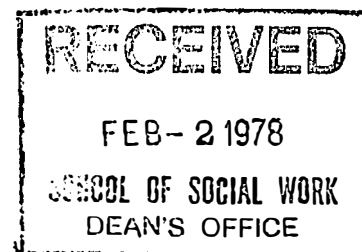


Dear Betty:

During the first meeting of the Staff Affairs Subcommittee of the Commission for Blacks for the 1977-78 academic year, we decided that certain documents are necessary in order for us to be effective. As I understand, a listing of all Black employees and their grade level is prepared for the Chancellor's Office periodically by the Personnel Office. We would like for you, as Chairperson of the Commission for Blacks, to secure the most recent copy of this listing. So that we can make comparison studies, we would also like a copy of the last listing that was done before the current document.

While I plan to request this information from Edward Bennett, we would like for you to contact Dr. Ebersole. I've talked to Mr. Bennett to invite him to meet with our subcommittee. He has graciously agreed to meet with us, but a date has not yet been finalized because he was not available for our next meeting on February 6. When I learned that Mr. Bennett could not be at our next meeting I thought that perhaps it might be to our advantage to gather as much information as we could beforehand. This, I think, might give us a stronger base from which to operate. In addition to the listing prepared for the Chancellor's Office we need a copy of the EEO report for 1976.

Betty, I know that you have a very busy schedule, but any information that you could get by February 6 when the staff affairs committee meets again would be appreciated.
