SUBJECT: U. T. K. Announcement of Vacancies.

Thank you for the vacancy announcement materials which I received on June 23rd. I was not previously aware of any listing of new and replacement positions to be filled during the academic years as was included in the memo from Hilton Smith. I am aware that replacement positions do become available at the School of Law during the period from January through May and are usually filled during that same period. I wonder if the School of Law has ever circulated any information concerning new and replacement positions on its faculty or professional staff to any other offices within the University concerned with Affirmative Action.

It is possible that this may not be the only college or department which fails to do so. Possibly this matter could be discussed at a future meeting of the commission.
