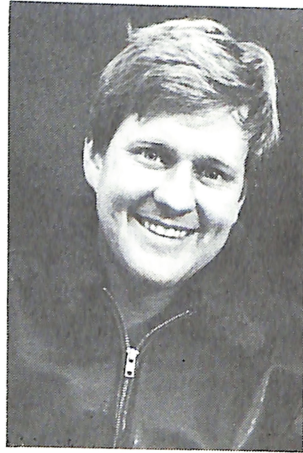

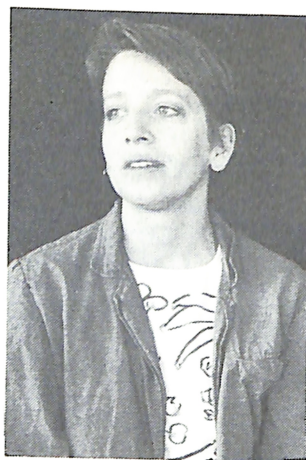

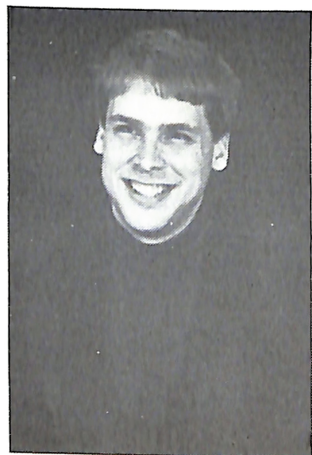

Ziggurat, 48" x 84", Acrylic, wood, plastic, speakers, electronic parts

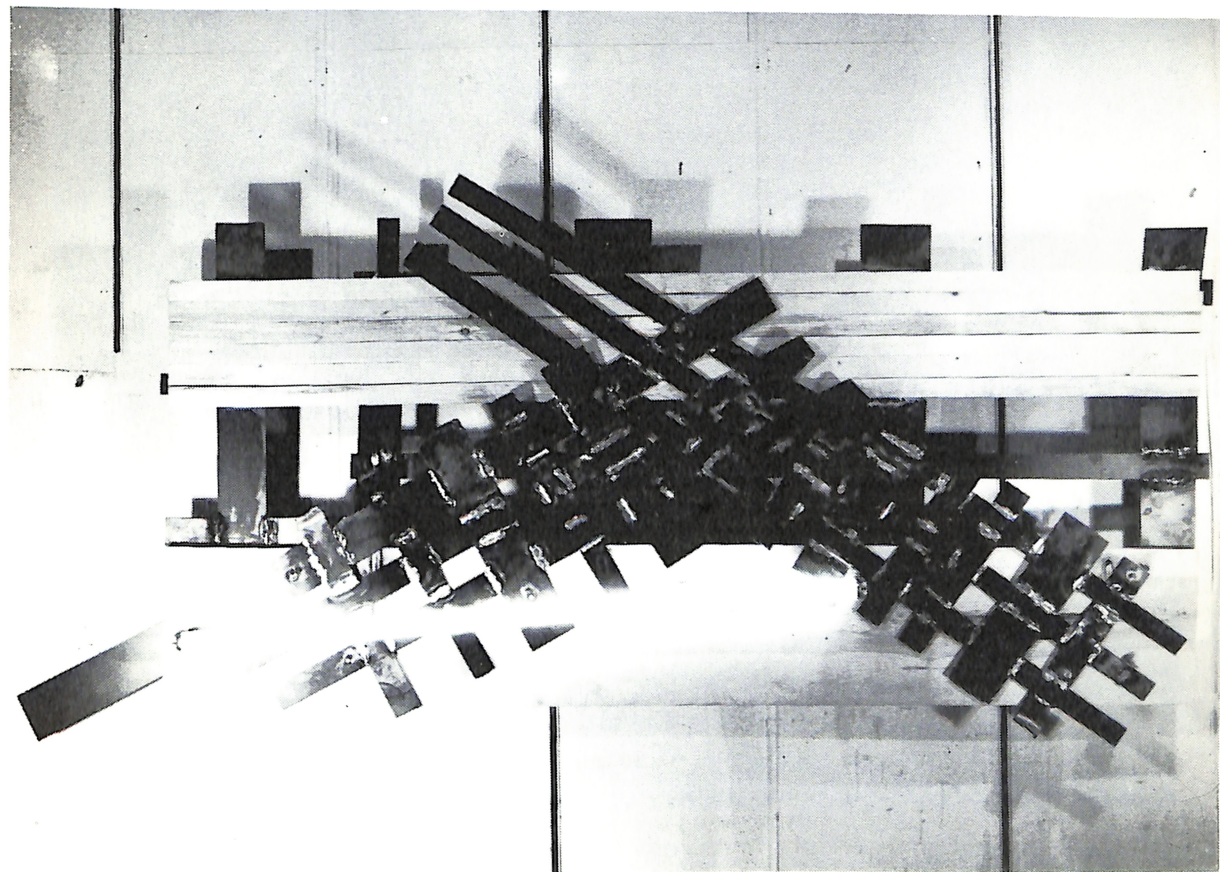

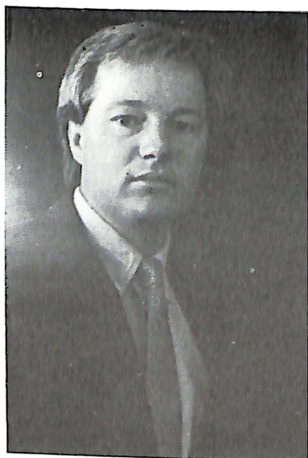

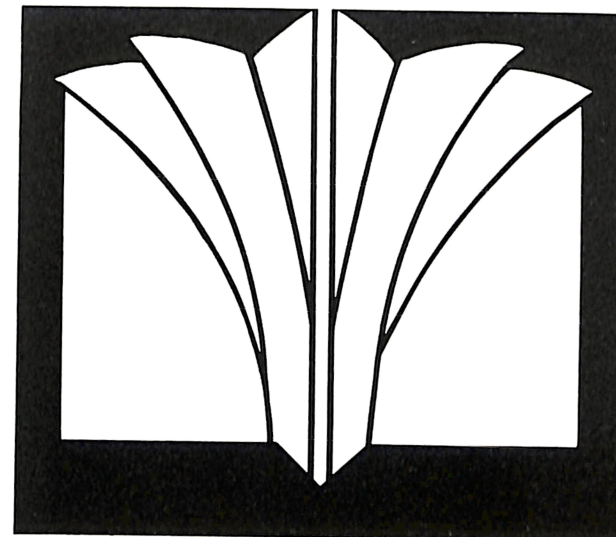
