SUMMARY OF GPOP FELLOWS, 1980-PRESENT

The Graduate and Professional Study Fellowship Program Grant (GPOP) is funded by the U.S. Department of Education on the basis of successful proposals, made annually, by the Associate Dean of The Graduate School. The purpose of the fellowships is to attract women and minorities to fields where they are underrepresented, both in numbers of students and professionals. The Proposal is made for specific fields of study, and is funded on the basis of institutional commitment and demonstrated need. Individual fellowships normally provide tuition and fees for 12 months, a \$4500 stipend, \$400 book allowance, \$500 travel allowance as approved by the student's advisor, and tutoring assistance as needed. Fellowships are renewable for a total of two years toward the Master's degree, and three years toward the Ph.D.
