Under pressure of the last letter sent him, which was in the nature of an ultimatum, Mr. Stough sent this letter about 5 p.m.:-

Knoxville, Tenn., June 6th 1916.

Board of Trustees,  
University of Tennessee.

Your recent favors received and your requests noted. I will be pleased to give you any information at hand before your committee in a joint meeting with the representatives of the Executive Committee of the Stough Evangelistic Campaign.

In reply to this President Ayres replied at once that he would call a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees at his office at 10 a.m. the next day and would be glad to receive Mr. Stough and the representatives of the Stough Campaign.
