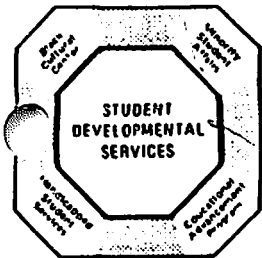

# HANDICAPPED SERVICES

## Recommendations:

It is difficult to determine the number of Black handicapped students at UTK. As a result, the low black enrollment may indicate:

- (i) there are fewer black handicapped students at UTK.
- (ii) the black students at UTK ~~do not~~ are not informed on the existing services available to them.
- (iii) black & handicapped students at UTK are not interested in the services.

However, the steady enrollment of blacks ~~to~~ on the program indicates progress, however, small in number.
