immediately following  
when perhaps some of  
the women had left  
the room.

The fact of the

universality of a double  
standard of morals, the  
necessity of it and  
his advocacy of it  
were most assuredly  
presented by Prof. Schaefer.

It is entirely possible  
this may have been  
in the conversation  
following the formal  
lecture. I shall unhesitatingly  
make the above statement  
under oath if desired.
