Re: Program Closure – Master of Science in Nursing (MSN)

Dear Belle,

The University of Tennessee, Knoxville's (UTK) College of Nursing faculty have discontinued the Master of Nursing degree in favor of an existing Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP). Students were no longer admitted after summer 2019, and the last graduates will finish matriculating in August 2021.

Due to multiple leadership changes in the College, the reporting of this closure was delayed. The programmatic accreditor, Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthetist Education Programs (COA) is also being notified at this time.

- Students were informed individually by faculty members during academic advising sessions, and a conspicuous statement was posted on the department's website for prospective students not yet in contact with faculty members or admissions staff.
- Faculty members were involved in the decision to close the program through the customary curricular process. No staff members have been impacted as a result of this change.
- Enrolled students will be able to matriculate through the MSN program until August 2021. There are no part-time or out-of-sequence students enrolled in the program.
- There were no additional charges or other expenses charged to students.
- The two full-time anesthesia faculty members are fully employed supporting both programs until August. Faculty and staff will be fully engaged supporting this and other programs in the College.
