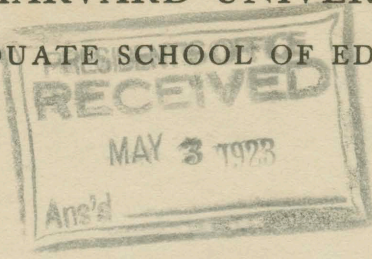

Dear Morgan:

Thanks for your reassuring letter. I should not wish to pursue the matter further, but since receiving it I have a letter from Dr Spewls asking my assistance in securing another position. I do not know Dr Spewls personally and perhaps you can tell me what you think of his qualifications to hold a position in Secondary Education under more favorable conditions than he seems to have found at Tennessee.

I am sorry that you and the University have suffered this unwelcome publicity, but since it has come upon you I hope you were able to denounce publicly the resolutions supporting your stand in the Spewls case which are reported to have been adopted by the congregations of the Fayetteville churches.
