## GUIDE TO USE OF THIS DIRECTORY

After the name of each city is the county name, in parenthesis, in which the city is located. After the county name is a letter showing in which grand division of the state the city is located, East, Middle, or West. The figure shown after the capital letter is the population of the city, which is usually the 1950 Federal census count, but in many cases this figure reflects annexations since 1950; all population data are those used by the State for distribution of State-shared taxes to municipalities. The last entry on this line is the telephone number, if any, of the city hall or other city office.

For each city that furnished the requested information, on the second line is shown the time and place of the meetings of the governing body, and on the third line is shown any closing of city offices during the week if this information was reported.

Municipal elections in Tennessee are held throughout the year, and changes are therefore constantly occurring. Each month new officials are announced in Tennessee Town & City magazine, the official organ of the Tennessee Municipal League. The magazine is sent free to municipal officials; others desiring to subscribe may do so by remitting the yearly subscription price of \$3.00 to the League office, 228 Capitol Blvd., Nashville 3, Tennessee.
