Dear Dr. Ebersole:

At a recent meeting of the Commission for Women, there was a discussion regarding lighting on UTK campus. We are recommending that the appropriate campus unit survey existing lighting on campus in order to determine if the lighting is adequate for the safety of individuals who are on campus during the evening hours.
