ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

This contested administrative case was originally heard in Dyersburg, Tennessee, on April 26, 2011, before J. Randall LaFevor, Administrative Judge, assigned by the Secretary of State and sitting for the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Safety. Mr. Andre Thomas, Staff Attorney for the Tennessee Department of Safety, represented the State. The Claimant appeared *pro se*. That hearing resulted in the entry of an Initial Order on May 10, 2011. On May 24, 2011, the Claimant filed a Petition for Reconsideration of the Initial Order.

The Claimant cited no factual or legal errors in the Initial Order in support of his Petition. A review of the record and the Initial Order was undertaken to determine the accuracy of the factual findings, and the correctness of the legal conclusions. That review has resulted in a determination that the Initial Order is appropriate in both respects, and will not be disturbed.

There being no basis found upon which relief can be granted, it is therefore ORDERED that the Claimant's Petition for Reconsideration is hereby DENIED.
