INITIAL ORDER


The subject of this hearing was the proposed forfeiture of the subject property for its alleged use in violation of TENN. CODE ANN. § 53-11-201 *et seq.* and § 40-33-201 *et seq.*

As a result of the failure of anyone to appear on behalf of the Franklin Police Department, Mr. Orr announced that Safety was withdrawing the Department's claim to the property. Accordingly, the Franklin Police Department is ORDERED to return the property to the Claimant.
