INITIAL ORDER

This matter was heard in Nashville, Tennessee, on September 11, 2006, before Mary M. Collier, Administrative Judge, assigned by the Secretary of State, and sitting for the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Safety ("Safety"). Orvil Orr, Staff Attorney for Safety, represented Safety. F. Shayne Brasfield, appeared on behalf of the Claimant. No officer or other witness appeared on behalf of the Franklin Police Department.

The subject of this hearing was the proposed forfeiture of the subject property for its alleged use in violation of TENN. CODE ANN. § 53-11-201 *et seq.* and § 40-33-201 *et seq.*

As a result of the failure of anyone to appear on behalf of the Franklin Police Department, Mr. Orr announced that Safety was withdrawing the Department's claim to the property. Accordingly, the Franklin Police Department is ORDERED to return the property to the Claimant.
