**ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

This contested case was set for hearing before Administrative Judge Kim Summers on August 13, 2014. Joe Bartlett, Staff Attorney, represented the Department of Safety. No one appeared to participate in the hearing on behalf of the Claimant.

On October 14, 2014, an Initial Order of Default and Dismissal was entered in the case. On October 20, 2014, the Claimant filed a Request for Reconsideration, asserting her belief, based upon communication with local law enforcement, that her attendance at the hearing was unnecessary.

Although the Claimant did receive the Notice of Hearing, there was, apparently, some confusion about the need to appear at the hearing in order to secure the interest in the subject vehicle. For this reason, the Claimant has provided good cause for the failure to participate in the previously scheduled hearing, and the Petition for Reconsideration is hereby **GRANTED**.

The Department of Safety shall reschedule the hearing in this matter and notify the Claimant of the time and date for the next scheduled hearing.
