AMENDED INITIAL ORDER

This matter was heard in Jackson, Tennessee on December 10, 2014, before J. Randall LaFevor, Administrative Judge assigned by the Secretary of State, Administrative Procedures Division, sitting for the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Safety. Mr. Joe Bartlett, Staff Attorney for the Tennessee Department of Safety, represented the State. The Claimant failed to appear.

On December 22, 2014, an Initial Default Order was entered in this case, directing that the Claimant's interest in the property be forfeited. A clerical error in the description of the seized property resulted in an incorrect style of that order. Pursuant to Rule 1360-4-1-.17, TENN. COMP. R. & REGS., *Uniform Rules of Procedure for Hearing Contested Cases Before State Administrative Agencies*, that error is hereby amended to reflect the correct description of the seized/forfeited property, which is set out in the style at the top of this *Amended Order*.
