Organized by graduate students in the Department of World Languages and Cultures (WLC) at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville (UTK), *Vernacular* is a peer-reviewed journal: submissions are evaluated by peer graduate students from different universities across the country. In addition, *Vernacular* is backed by an advisory board composed of distinguished professors.

Vernacular is dedicated to sharing current academic investigations and creative works by current graduate students in language, literature, and culture or in comparable disciplines from universities around the globe. The journal accepts high-quality submissions of scholarly essays, book reviews, interviews, and translations, as well as short stories and poetry. We welcome entries written in English, French, German, or Spanish.
